Fire & EMS Department Report – The January 2021 Report shows there were a total of 21 calls. 14 of those calls were EMS natured, 5 were Fire natured, 1 mutual aid assistance, and 1 motor vehicle accident. The Granger Fire Department has started the new year with kicking off another Firefighter 1 course. New members and members from neighboring communities learn the practical and cognitive training needed to operate safely and effectively on the fireground. The course promotes our members the ability to grasp a high-level skill competency and a thorough understanding of their role during a fire scene. Class takes place weekly on Monday/Wednesday at the GFD station. Also for January, Sam Palmer celebrates 2 years of service and Tory Browne celebrates 4 years of service with the GFD.
