IOWA STATE REVOLVING FUND FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

The Granger New Water Tower Project has undergone an Environmental Review. A document called the Finding of No Significant Impact (FNSI) has been issued for this project. If you have any comments about the project, you can send them to <u>SRF-PC@dnr.iowa.gov</u> by March 9, 2024. If no objections are received during the 30-day comment period, the FNSI will be finalized, and the environmental review will be considered complete.

The Granger Public Works Department will pick up your yard waste each Monday and Friday morning (free service) as long as you adhere to the following: Yard waste means any debris such as grass clippings, leaves, garden waste, brush and trees. Yard waste should be bagged and tied and NO MORE than 50 lbs. and set out by your curb for pickup. Tree branches should be cut down to 3 feet long and tied. We appreciate your cooperation.
