**FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT**

The Granger New Water Tower Project has undergone an Environmental Review. A document called the Finding of No Significant Impact (FNSI) has been issued for this project. If no objections are received during the 30-day comment period, the FNSI will be finalized, and the environmental review will be considered complete.
